

# Speech – Opening Lines

## Climate Change

Everybody here would have some thoughts on why Climate Change isn't being solved. When everybody in the world with any power now claims they believe and say they want to solve why aren't we solving it? When we get to the end of this talk ask yourself if we're still going to have those problems now.

I've been working on something much bigger than just Climate Change for the last eighteen years, and I've come here today to introduce you to what I've been working on by telling you how we're going to solve Climate Change.

I have no humility about what I'm putting forward here today because it is not ambiguous in the least; we are about to solve Climate Change, and if you're not with me by the end of this talk, then you will be after you read the Climate Change discussion paper you can find on the H3 web.

The more cynical you are the more clearly you're going to see that we're about to solve Climate Change completely. It's that sort of approach. Everybody with money and power in this world only needs to be greedy for money, power, fame and acclaim inside this new approach and we get this thing done. Like I said, it's that sort of approach.

For those who have a tablet with them and want to multitask they can go to [h3hq.org](http://h3hq.org) and have a look at the discussion papers as I'm speaking. I say tablet because although most of the pdfs on the H3 web are formatted for easy viewing on a phone, the discussion papers are a bit too big to have done that.

Let's go:

There are five elements in the H3 approach to Climate Change.

1. There is a new global economic agreement to replace the Kyoto Protocol and COP21,
2. a complete solution for deforestation that will add over 200 million hectares of plantation forest and a trillion dollars of new assets into the global economy,

3. a complete solution for overfishing that will add about a half a trillion dollars into the global economy, and it will return the volume of life in the oceans back to what it was centuries ago (the CC relevance is that it's also a massive carbon sink),
4. new zero emission technology, which can come from a number of different sources at this point,
5. And a global economic reform that will absolutely guarantee the fossil fuels industry will be 100% and genuinely behind the redundancy of their industry.

The first two reforms we go into are a bit mundane and trudgy, but the other two reforms are big and flashy and obvious. Let's go through these five elements in order.....
